MINUTES OF AUGUST MEETING

August 31, 1971


The regular meeting of MARAC, Inc. was held July 31, 1971 at QTH of WSJE. The meeting was called to order at 2030 by WAGWOB. This meeting called early due to the Mini-Convention being held in Peoria, Ill. next weekend. Minutes of July meeting were accepted as presented in the July Newsletter. Members present were WAGWOB, WGSJE, KGAYO, WAGZCQ and WYIN. KGAYO reported on WBGDPD county confirmation progress. 488 counties confirmed, 171 more worked. County hunter QSL bureaus were discussed. WAKA had volunteered to start one but W6CCM has one already. WGSJE discussed awards and presented draft for qualification for the merit award which was accepted and will be published in this newsletter. WAGWOB made motion to present the MARAC Merit Award to Mr. Bob Bergert of the Prom-Sheraton Motel, seconded by WGYIN. MARAC Mobile award discussed, draft of proposed qualifications to be included in this newsletter. Under new business the Mini-Convention in Peoria, Ill. was discussed. The main topic was how MARAC and the Newsletter could be of help to the ICHN 72 Convention Committee. At 2215 KGAYO made motion to adjourn, seconded by WAGZCQ. Next meeting to be at the QTH of WGYIN.

The Slate meeting for the 5th annual convention, the Cliff Corne Memorial, was held Saturday Aug. 7, at the Ramada Inn, Peoria, Ill. Ramada Inn management welcomed the group and aided greatly in the discussion of the pricing of the various events. Extensive time was devoted to means of financing the convention. Agreement on costs of the banquets and Dutch supper. Convention Staff proposed station call — KP9EAB, as a memorial call to K9EAB. Request for authorization from FCC to be acted upon immediately.
