MINUTES OF THE MARAC MONTHLY MEETING

The Executive Committee was called into session at 9:00 A.M. on December 6, 1986 by WBØTVL at Michael's Restaurant, Holiday Inn East, ST. Paul, Minn. Present were: WBØTVL, NØDRX, NØDXH, WBØKIN, WØKMH, W9LHG, WAØLKL, NOØU, KBØXB, WØWVO and WBØUPU. WBØTVL stated that it was again necessary to announce members who will be serving on the Nominating Committee for 1987, and pursuant to the Bylaws, the following were appointed: Chairman, WØKMH, KBØXB, WAØLKL, WBØUPU, NOØU, WBØKIN and K9DCJ. All present indicated a willingness to serve and were unanimously approved. Any member not in attendance will be contacted by WBØUPU, who volunteered to act as Secretary to the Committee.

The Executive Committee was adjourned and the general meeting was then convened, with attendance as indicated above.

The Minutes of the November meeting as published in the Newsletter were introduced. Motion to accept by WA \emptyset LKL, second by WB \emptyset KIN, approved.

Copies of the Treasurer's report were then handed out by W9LHG. Motion to accept by WØKMH, second by KBØXB, approved.

WBØTVL reported that Bob Kemp. WA4CHI, was gathering his committed in preparation for the 1987 Convention in the Longmont, Colorado area and that the usual "seed money" of \$750.00 had been sent to assist in preliminary arrangements. In addition, WØOWY had agreed to accept the appointment as Convention Coordinator inasmuch as Les, WB8SNO would be unable to continue. WBØTVL will assist in the transition of duties.

WBØUPU reported that the following positions will be voted on prior to the Annual Meeting: President, Vice-president, Secretary, Treasurer; Headquarters Director, currently held by WAØLKL; North Central Director, currently held by KD9Q; and Great Lakes Director, currently held by WB8SNO. Any group of members in any particular area wishing to present a slate of officers for consideration should notify any member of the Nomination Committee, keeping in mind that, according to the Bylaws, the officers of each slate should reside within an area having a radius of approximately 100 miles. The Nominating Committee will also solicit nominations for the appropriate area Director positions.

WBØTVL, speaking as Awards Committee Chairman, stated that the committee was currently studying various award formats in anticipation of presenting a MARAC award for giving out all counties. He anticipates a full report at the next meeting.
