

#### **NOTES**

We have gotten several requests from stations who do not regularly receive mailings from QSL Bureau for a copy of the Bureau Drawer. As you know, we send this each time we mail, so the following will not apply to all, but: If you wish to receive each issue of the Bureau Drawer and do not regularly get mailings from us, please send a supply of #10 SASEs and we will send a copy to you. Please include your call sign on the SASE as we file by amateur call for all Bureau records, rather than by name.

As stated above, do not send SASEs if you will receive copies of the Bureau Drawer by virture of the fact that you get mailings from us monthly. We will include a copy in your mailings.

We have received a few notes from stations who have faithfully sent out QSL cards with the first MRC submitted to another station as was of comment a few issues back. They have correctly noted that they failed to receive a return card from the mobilers in some instances. Mobilers, please note, we provide sufficient postage for the return of an equal number of cards we send to you, so you are encouraged to return QSLs for cards received.

As a result of looking at thousands of QSL cards each month here at the Bureau, I would like to comment on the fact that if the proper boxes or indications of PSE QSL and TNX QSL are properly used on the cards, everyone gets better results. The way we understand it, if you want a return QSL, mark the PSE QSL. If you are returning a QSL, mark the TNX QSL. If you mark neither, you probably will not get a return. Some mark both! What is one to do???
